Casper Stockham Throws Hat in the Ring for Colorado Republican Party Chair to Restore Purpose to the CO GOP

DENVER CO, December 7 – Casper Stockham has announced his bid to become the Colorado GOP's new chair beginning next year. He revealed his intentions at this morning's Arapahoe County Republican breakfast along with his OPERATION OUST strategy designed to getting the GOP back to helping the people of Colorado and putting state Democrats on notice.

For the past decade, Stockham has served Colorado's Republican Party as a candidate, campaign manager and strategist, campaign worker, precinct worker, GOP executive committee board member and a conservative advocate for issues key to the community. "I have the battle scars to prove it," he says.

"As GOP chair, I will restore the purpose of our party in Colorado which is more than just getting Republicans elected to office. It's about helping more people by getting good men and women elected to public office in this state. It's a subtle difference. But by helping Coloradans more, we will win more elections."

Stockham's plan is straightforward. Operation O.U.S.T.

O stands for Outreach. "We must do a better job of reaching out to voters in Colorado," he says. "Get Out the Vote (GOTV) should be the icing on the cake, not the cake. The work for GOTV must start now."

The **U** means Unity. "Let's face it, the Colorado GOP is like a dysfunctional family," says Stockham. "It is imperative that we do a better job of working toward common goals that fulfil our purpose to help more people. It's essential we stop ignoring our base."

The **S** stands for Support. "We've done a mediocre job of supporting our candidates, counties, volunteers and the voters," he claims. "To win more races, we must be unflinching in our support for all three."

The **T** prioritizes Training. Stockham, as an established candidate trainer, emphasizes, "We need to recruit and train thousands of individuals to run for office in Colorado races ranging from local boards to the Governor's office."

He believes the way forward is simple but could take several election cycles to forge this kind of change. "To save our party, we must stop the bleeding and grow our base."

Stockham is committing to do all of this for at least six years, provided that demonstrable change is noticeable in the first two years. "I am in this for the long haul because I believe this kind of commitment to who we are and why the Colorado GOP exists is absolutely required," he stated.
